SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. THE EVENT

The event a Multi-Club Autocross shall be known as Round 2 of the Victorian Club Autocross Series (VCAS) and will hereafter be referred to as The Event. The event will be a timed autocross for holders of a current club membership with CAMS affiliated car clubs.

5. AUTHORITY

The event will be held under the International Sporting code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS), the Speed Event Standing Regulations, Autocross Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations which may be issued. The event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found at www.cams.com.au

6. PLACE AND DATE

The event will be held at the **Kyneton Car Club track**, **(Rollinson Reserve, see instructions)**. This is a **Daylight Event on Sunday 17th March**, **2013**. Gates open at **7.30am** and Scrutiny will commence at **8.00am**. Competitors must present their CAMS Licence, Club Membership Card & Car Log Book, (if issued) at scrutiny. Drivers briefing will be at **9.30am**. Official runs will commence by **10.00am** and finish by **4.00pm**. Food and drinks will be available at venue.

7. ENTRIES

(a) Entries will open at 9am on the 6/03/2013 and close at 5.30pm on Wed the 13/03/2013.

Entries are to be sent to Rodney Stone at 3A Langford Street Surrey Hills 3127, with the correct \$55 entry fee. Entry fee for juniors is \$35. Cheques or money orders should be made payable to "Kyneton Car Club Inc." Entries will be limited to 80 entries. To ensure your entry enter early.

The Promoter reserves the right to refuse entry in accordance with NCR83.

8. INSURANCE

- (a) Public risk insurance has been effected by the Promoters.
- (b) All drivers and officials are covered by the motorsport personal accident policy.
- (c) For further details, refer to Appendix I of the 2013 CAMS Manual of Motor sport.
- (d) "Passengers shall be permitted in a race or speed event only by written permission of the CEO of CAMS" Refer NCR 46

9. CLASSES

Drivers will be graded into classes:- A - 0 to 2000cc Std. (road tyres), B - over 2000cc Std. (road tyres),

- $\textbf{C}-0\text{-}1600\text{cc Modified}, \quad \textbf{D}-1601 \text{ to } 2000\text{cc Modified}, \quad \textbf{E}-\text{over } 2000\text{cc Modified}, \quad \textbf{J}-\text{Juniors}, \quad \textbf{L}-\text{Ladies}, \quad \textbf{L}-\text{La$
- ${\bf S}$ Specials (Custom built cars & excessively modified sedans), ${\bf W}$ Production based 4WD & AWD Note:

Vehicles using Rally Tyres are graded as modified for their class; Turbo-charged and Supercharged vehicles are graded as 1.7 times their engine capacity and rotary vehicles are graded as 1.8 times their engine capacity.

• Juniors and Ladies entered in cars eligible for classes W and S must be entered in those classes.

10. STARTING ORDER

Start in numerical order. Starting order within each class will be determined by the order of receipt of entry, with drivers of shared vehicles suitably spaced to allow changeovers with minimal disruption to the event.

11. DRIVERS

(a) All drivers must hold and present a CAMS level 2S License or superior, a current membership card for a CAMS affiliated car club and vehicle logbook (if issued).

All competitors are required to wear snug fitting clothes covering the body from neck to wrist to ankles and suitable footwear. Clothing should be of a fire resistant nature and comply with Schedule D of the 2013 CAMS Manual.

12. COURSE

The event will be run in a clockwise direction over a single track of up to 1.2km (approx.) of gravel defined by tyres, witches hats and bunting. All runs will be timed from a flying start.

13. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

- (a) Vehicles must conform to the general requirements of automobiles in competition (General Requirements for Cars and Drivers, Schedules A and B of the current CAMS manual). All vehicles must be fitted with a suitable front and back towing hook.
- (b) All vehicles must utilize two separate fastening systems on any front opening panel.
- (c) Fire extinguishers to a standard listed in Schedule H of the CAMS Manual must be securely fitted to the vehicle.
- (d) Safety helmets must conform to Schedule D of the CAMS Manual requirements (eg AS 1698) and be worn whilst competing.
- (e) All vehicles (except road registered vehicles in class A or B) must be fitted with mud flaps on all driven wheels and on both rear wheels. All vehicles must have mudguards covering all road wheels
- (f) Any vehicles competing in Class S must be fitted with rollover protection as outlined in Schedule J. Rollover protection is highly recommended in all other cases
- (g) Winter tread tyres, mud & snow tyres are not to be used. A full set of <u>Rally tyres</u> (designated for competition only) or <u>conventional road tyres</u> are permitted across all classes.
- (h) Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual.

14. RUNNING DETAIL

Results will be determined by the competitors fastest 3 out of 3, or best 3 of however many runs. The number of runs will be determined by the Clerk of Course, dependent on the condition of the track. Timing will be controlled with manual stop clocks in control tower. The Timekeeper will be deemed Judge of Fact.

Note: A condition of the use of Rollinson Reserve is that Kyneton Car Club takes all necessary precautions to restrict dust pollution to neighbouring properties. As a consequence regular watering of the track throughout the event is imperative. The watering of the track requirements will be at the absolute discretion of the Clerk of Course.

15. STARTING PROCEDURE

Competitors will line up in numerical order and will be moved onto the starting pad immediately after the previous competitor has departed. The starter will indicate to the driver when to proceed onto the course. Any competitor who encounters difficulties on the course will be permitted a re-run at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

16. FINISH PROCEDURE

At the end of each run the driver is to immediately decelerate the vehicle and proceed to the pit area. At all times when moving within the pit area, and leaving the autocross area, the maximum speed limit is to be 10kph.

17. TERMINATION

The Organisers, reserve the right to stop the event at any time if they consider it necessary, in the interests of safety or for any other reason.

18. POSTPONEMENTS OR ABANDONMENT

The Organisers, reserve the right to postpone, abandon, or cancel the event under NCR 59, and if the event is cancelled or postponed for more than 24 hours, the entry fees shall be refunded in full.

Note: The meet will be cancelled if the day is declared a "Total Fireban / Code Red" for the "Central District".

19. AWARDS-

Trophies will be presented to the following drivers

- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Outright
- 1st in each class (2 or more entries in class)
- 2nd in each class (>5 entries in class)
- 3rd in each class (>10 entries in class)

20. ANTI DOPING POLICY

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

The CAMS Anti Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such.

In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti Doping Policy will take precedence.

21. NOISE

Vehicles must not exceed a noise limit of 95dB (A).

22. PENALTIES

(a) Shortening the course - 10 seconds per instance

Dislodging penalty markers - 5 seconds per instance

(b) Any breach of these Supplementary Regulations will be dealt with in the same manner as breaches of all other regulations pertaining to the event

23. PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

24. FURTHER REGULATIONS.

The organisers reserve the right to issue competitors with further regulations. Such regulations will have the same authority as these regulations.

HOW TO GET THERE

From Melbourne Come up the Calder Freeway take the second Kyneton turnoff (Redesdale). Turn right at the roundabout and cross the bridge (over Freeway). Take the first turn left (sale yards road). Follow this road approx 2km, pass the cemetery (on the left), then the track is on your right (Rollinson Reserve) next to the tip.
